National Ranking and Selection Policy, 2023-24

A. Purpose

The policy aims to provide clear and unambiguous guidelines for the selection and seeding of Indian teams in various categories for participation and representation in international competitions.

The above policy will be relevant for the following WBF Events:

- a) World Bridge Games Country Representation for *Teams* (to be held at Centro de Convenciones de Buenos Aires, Argentina from 22nd October up to and including the 5th November 2024). Pairs event will open for Indian players.
- b) Any World Bridge Tour event where BFI is invited to send an INDIAN representative team
- c) Any International invitation event sent to BFI where INDIAN representative team is required through nomination or trials.

The Ranking Points for the events considered for previous selection trial (2022-23) will be given at 50% weightage in addition to the current Ranking points considered for selection trials 2023-24.

This policy has been formulated by the members of the nominated Ranking Committee appointed by Bridge Federation of India upon instructions of its Executive committee.

The Ranking Committee has undertaken several inputs as guided by the previously announced Ranking policies of the years 2022, 2021 and 2018 and with the recent selection committee appraisal of performance of the athletes at BFAME Championships (Lahore), APBF Championships (Hongkong), 46th World Championships (Morocco) and Asian Games 2022(Hangzhou) in addition with the suggestions given by the appointed coaches of BFI.

As compared to the targets mentioned in the TOPS scheme of SAI, the achievements by the athletes selected during the year 2023 in the major tournaments (APBF, World Championships and Asian Games) has to be improved with the known expectation of a medal in the Men category at Asian Games.

As recommended, the focus area of the current policy is to strengthen the ongoing process of selection through more phases of coaching camps and selecting a core of probable based on performances at these camps and impart online coach training. However, these stated guidelines will also be applicable to any and all future competitions.

The committee reserves the rights to modify the policy at a later date, said modifications will be widely published on BFI website as well as other communication channels, and the applicability of these modifications will be clearly defined.

The policy aims to establish the following:

- The policy will include the qualifying events from 1st April 31st March unless repeated for same calendar year.
- Time bound performance evaluation criteria
 - o Period of evaluation
 - O Respective weights of periodic performance (emphasis on more recent performance)
- Events to be considered for purpose of evaluation
- Respective weights of events considered
- Sponsored Pairs will not be eligible for ranking points if they have played the qualification stages of that respective
 event.
- Any Individual player who forms part of the main Qualifying list (excluding reserve quota) can form a new
 partnership with another individual provided both individuals are part of the Qualified list. Each individual will carry
 30% weightage of their highest-ranking points mentioned in the qualified list (including previous year ranking points
 if any). The new pair will be given ranking points based on the average of the sum of ranking points given to both
 individuals.
- Ranking points for any Team with more than 2 foreign/OCI players will be void. Immaterial of any composition there must be at least 2 pairs having Indian passport in domestic or international events.

Note: In case of one foreign / OCI player or pair in the team of any ranking event, the ranking points will be awarded to the other eligible Indian Pairs of that respective team at one third of the eligible ranking points. The OCI/Foreign Player will not be awarded any ranking points as well to all the partnerships such player has played with in that respective event.

A special provision will be kept for those ladies' pairs, who are reaching the last-16 positions of a ranking point team / pair competition (not qualifying events), they will be given the prorate weightage of ranking points equivalent to the ranking. Say if 8th position ranking points are 10, then 9th position will get 15/16*10, 14/16*10 (for 10th ranked) and so on. *This will be effective from 1st April, 2024*

Qualification benchmarks for various categories

Top 24 Ranked Pairs in Men/Open category, 18 Pairs in Mixed and 12 Pairs in Women.

Furthermore, there will be eligibility of 4 reserves in each category to fulfil above quota provided all entries are received within the notified date. For e.g., in men category the quota will be 24 pairs + 4 reserves.

- Process and procedure to be followed during selection trials
- When the target events include men's category but not open
- When the target events include open category but not men
- When the target events include both (in same or different events)

D. Scope

- This policy will be applicable to Open/Men, Women and Mixed Categories.
- Exceptionally performing exceptional Girls and boys from junior's category will be included in the above list as per recommendation of Juniors Selection committee.
- Players to be selected for Juniors World Championship for Juniors and Sub Juniors will be dealt separately with a separate Ranking Point Scheme
- As per the guidelines, the terminology used "athlete" as defined by the MYAS and SAI mean a single identity, thus, in Bridge it would be "pair".

E. Performance Evaluation

The process of performance evaluation is quantified by awarding ranking points to participating athletes based on the performance in the scheduled events over an extended period.

- Points are awarded exclusively for partnerships only. However, individual players forming new
 partnerships can avail 30% of the highest-ranking points awarded to him/her in any partnership
 based on the total ranking points published for the respective selection cycle in contention provided
 both individuals are part of the original qualified list of pair of that respective category. The average
 of both the total ranking points calculated above will be actual ranking point awarded for that
 respective pair.
- In case where team is of 5-members, the eligible pair will be the one, which plays maximum number
 of boards in combination wherever possible to be determined. In case of more than 3 partnerships
 for any team, the captain should announce the defined three partnerships for eligibility of ranking
 points subject to fulfilment of playing quota criteria.

1) Performance period

For purposed of evaluation of performance the performance period will be as follows

Total Period of consideration – *Two full calendar years* (1st April to 31st March) immediately preceding the year of selection trials + the year of selection trials up to the notification and invitation of entries subject to non-repetition.

Definition – Calendar year of Trials = TYYY

Period of consideration	Factor of ranking points earned in the period

2) Scheduled Events

a) International events:

- Events organized under the auspices or by World bridge Federation where representation is by NBO (BFI selects the team). Open international events where players participate on their own are not considered for awards.
- Zonal events Asia Pacific Bridge Championships (ABPF Zone IV, VI & VII) held once in 2 years (only team events). Competitive nations in Asian Games
- BFAME Championships (Zone IV) where Indian teams participate after selection trials or nominated by selection panel of BFI.
- International Recognized Events by WBF (only LIVE events)— World Bridge Tour and under OCA (Olympic Committee of Asia) in which INDIA is recognized as a member nation or is invited due to performance achievement for which the trials are conducted or the team is nominated by selection panel of BFI.
- b) National Championships organized under auspices of BFI (Open/Mixed/Women)
- c) All India National Events of selection berth Category A events
- d) Zonal Events
- e) Specific designated events exclusively for Mixed or Ladies Categories

Ranking Point Weightages

- The specific events, their weightages and awards are defined in Annexure 1.
- The BFI reserves the right to add or remove any event from the designated event list.
- The BFI reserves the right to modify the weightages of ranking point awards to any scheduled event.
- Starting with April 01, 2022, pairs events will be awarded at 50% of the ranking points award for corresponding team's event for Men/open events only. However mixed and ladies pairs event will be awarded at 25% of the ranking points for main teams event wherever applicable.
- There will be no change in ranking points awarded up to 1st April, 2023 as per the revised ranking policy 2021. For the years 2023-24, the ranking points for HCL International event will have weightage of 90% of BFI Federation events w.e.f. from 1-1-2023. Also any ranking points awarded for non-qualifying events from the year 2022 will be removed.
- All teams or pairs attaining the same rank will be awarded the average of ranks of all such positions.
 - e.g. teams finishing in 5-8 position, if they all have these ranks by way of being losing quarter finalists, will be awarded the average of 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th position respectively.

F. Qualification benchmark for selection trials

At the time of invitation of entries, the total Ranking Points of all Pairs as per their performance in the respective events will be consolidated and computed with due application of weightage formula defined above. From the overall list, the following will be invited to participate in the selection trials in their respective category:

- 1) Open Category Top 24 Ranked Pairs
- 2) Mixed Category Top 18 Ranked Pairs
- 3) Women Category Top 12 Ranked Pairs
- There will be additions to the above list in any category in case of any dropouts to fulfil the above mentioned criteria list of qualifying pairs.
- In case where the target event has men's category but not open, top 24 men's pairs will be

- invited from open list.
- In case where the combined trials are held for open and men's category, top 24 pairs from open list will be invited.
- Except where one or both members of a partnership are deceased, all partnerships will be fully recognized for consideration of the qualifying list and multiple partnerships will be considered legitimate for computation of the qualifying list.
- As per National Sports Code, BFI reserves the right to invite any additional pairs not in above eligible
 qualifying benchmark list based on exceptional performance provided such pairs have undergone
 training for at least 180 days with any BFI accredited national coach. The nominated pair should be
 approved by the Indian Selection Committee panel.
- In case there is a change in the partnership and both players are selected as per qualification benchmark within their category with some other players as partners, the changed partnership can participate in the trials subject to both individuals forming part of the qualification list. However, they will carry average of the ranking points at 30% of their highest-ranking points in any partnership mentioned in the qualified list.
- BFI reserves the right to prohibit a player from participating in the selection trials provided it finds
 unfit on any of the following grounds. In such cases the constituent pair will get eliminated
 - 1. Case with disciplinary committee, past and present record, Player not in good standing with federation
 - 2. Physical and health reasons duly assessed by Medical officer of BFI
 - 3. Past records and unfavourable report by of Coach, NPC while representing India.
 - 4. Misbehaviour at Coaching camps and reported by Coaching Camp director and Coach
 - 5. Absence at Coaching camp
 - 6. Unfit under NADA

G. Process and procedures at the selection trials

These procedures refer to Open/Men, Mixed and Ladies categories. The senior trials are handled separately. The selection trials will be held live under guidelines issued by SAI in form of evaluation of coaching camps and competitions. The camps will consist of Elimination and Final stages. The number of elimination stages, and qualifications will be based on number of actual entries, based on the following table:

Weightages will be given to camp performance; ranking points will be based on the table below:

Note:- For the purpose of calculation of carry forward score, the camp performance for each pair will be sum of points awarded for VP score + win loss ratio + carry forward from previous stage if any. The highest point earner will receive 10 points and other pairs will be proportionately awarded as per their camp performance score to the highest leader.

H. Selection of team

The top 3 pairs from each category, along with pair #4 as first reserve will constitute the selected team. The selected team and the reserve pair will undertake to follow and attend any coaching and training program devised by BFI. Lack of preparation or discipline during the training program can lead to the coaches making a recommendation to substitute the selected pairs with next reserve.

In case Men and Open teams are selected via a common trial, the following process will apply:

- 1. Top 3 pairs irrespective of gender will form part of Open Team.
- 2. Top 3 men pairs will form part of Men's Team.

National Ranking and Selection Policy

Annexure 1 - Ranking Points

A. Ranking point Weightages for different ranks

For all events, top 8 ranks (unless specified otherwise in clause B below) will be awarded ranking points as per the table below. Actual events, and Ranking points for rank 1 in each event are defined in detail.

The example table depicts percentage of awards with 100% for rank 1 for teams.

B. Qualifying events for Selection trials and Ranking Points

1) WBF Championship events where representation is by NBO (these are the highest ranked international event for performance points ranking scheme and will have 100% point scale of 176)

Awards (Ranking Points) – Top 8 Places to be awarded (Rank 1 Teams = 176 points, Rank 1 Open Pairs = 88 points).

For World Bridge Tour Event: (For Teams and Pairs)

- Category A: Weightage will be 75% of WBF Championship events
- Category B: Weightage will be 50% of WBF Championship events
- Category C: Weightage will be 35% of WBF Championship events

The Ranking points will be awarded only for the Team event and Pair event for the main designated event of that championship and no stratified or side events will be eligible.

2) International Zonal Events – Asian Games, APBF (75% WBF events performance points provided such Indian Team qualifies for the Semi Final spot in the main team event)

Awards (Ranking Points) Rank 1 Teams = 132, Rank 1 Open Pairs = NIL

3) BFAME and Commonwealth Games where BFI selects or nominates a team (25% of WBF events performance points provided such Indian Team qualifies for the Semi Final spot in the main team event)

Awards (Ranking Points) - Rank 1 Teams = 44, Rank 1 Open Pairs = Nil

- 4) National Championships by Federation (these are highest ranked domestic event and are awarded 50% of WBF events performance points)
 - Winter nationals
 - Summer Nationals

Awards (Ranking Points) – Rank 1 Teams = 88, Rank 1 Open Pairs = 44

- **a)** National Events for selection Berth (events of National importance and are awarded 75% of National Championships performance points)
 - Interstate National Bridge Championships
 - Yeshwant Rao Holkar Trophy, Indore
 - Shree Cement, Kolkata
 - Mohanlal Bhartia Memorial, Delhi
 - Tolani Open National Masters

Awards (Ranking Points) – Rank 1 Teams = 66, Rank 1 Open Pairs = 33

International Events held in India:

Being part of World Bridge Tour:

- If HCL International is part of World Bridge Tour, the ranking points will be awarded as stated above as per the category of event it is placed in.
- If HCL International, Delhi is not part of World Bridge Tour, it will be awarded 90% of National Championships performance points

Awards (Ranking Points) - Rank 1 Teams = 79.2, Rank 1 Open Pairs = 39.6

- b) Zonal & Other Events (held each year where BFI accords recognition in advance will be eligible for 25% of National Championships performance points) subject to payment of capitation fees for ranking points:
 - Delhi Gymkhana not held in 2022,2023 & 2024
 - FNCC, Hyderabad not eligible for ranking points
 - East Zone Championships eligible for 2023
 - West Zone (President's cup) not held in 2022, 2023

Awards (Ranking Points) - Rank 1 Teams = 22, Rank 1 Open Pairs = Nil

 Events exclusively for Mixed Category (Pairs will be awarded 25% of National championships performance points)

There will be 2 categories of events:

National Level Mixed Events:

- Smt. Vijaya Jajoo National Mixed championships (66 Ranking Points)
- Prime Mixed National Teams and Pairs

Other Ranking Mixed Events:

- Dr. K.K. Bhatnagar Memorial Mixed Pairs event
- Qualifying Events for Mixed Category if held at Summer Nationals or Winter Nationals
- Any other event deemed to be a ranking point event at a future date.

Ranking Points Awards:

National Level Mixed Events:

- In case of Teams and Pairs event held together, Ranking points will be: Team event (Rank 1 Teams 66 points, Pairs event = 22 points).
- In case only Pairs event is held then Ranking points will be 66 points.

Other Mixed Events:

Ranking Points Awards:

- In case of Teams and Pairs event held together, Ranking points will be: Team event (Rank 1 Teams 22 points, Pairs event = 22 points).
- In case only Pairs event is held then Ranking points will be 22 points.
- **d)** Events exclusively for Ladies Category (Pairs will be awarded 25% of National championships performance points)

National Level Women Events:

Ranking Points Awards:

- In case of Teams and Pairs event held together, Ranking points will be: Team event(Rank 1 Teams 66 points, Pairs event = 22 points).
- In case only Pairs event is held then Ranking points will be 66 points.

Other Women Events:

Ranking Points Awards:

- In case of Teams and Pairs event held together, Ranking points will be:
 Team event (Rank 1 Teams 22 points, Pairs event = 22 points).
- In case only Pairs event is held then Ranking points will be 22 points.

Non-National Qualifying Events:

- Fenesta Ladies Pairs.
- Prime Ladies Pairs
- Qualifying events for Ladies category if held at Summer Nationals or Winter Nationals
- Any other event deemed to be a ranking point event at a future date.
