India Invited to Compete in Pacific-Asia Secondary School Bridge Championship

The Asia Pacific Bridge Federation (APBF) has extended an invitation to the BFI to participate in the Pacific-Asia Inter-Secondary School Bridge Championship 2025, set to be held in Shanghai from December 27, 2024, to January 1, 2025. This prestigious event, the first of its kind in the Asia-Pacific region, will be hosted by the China School Sports Federation and co-organized by the Shanghai School Sports Federation. BFI has been invited to send one Open team and one Girls' team, with team names representing their respective cities. APBF will provide a subsidy covering at least 50% of the accommodation expenses for players and coaches. Interested teams should submit their proposals to Hon. Secretary Mr. Debasish Ray (bfisecretary2020@gmail.com). BFI will soon announce the selection process for the Indian representative teams.
