India's Performance at the 16th World Bridge Games in Buenos Aires

India has participated in all categories at the 16th World Bridge Games, being held in Buenos Aires, Argentina, from 22nd October to 3rd November. Representing the nation in the Open, Mixed, Seniors, and Women's categories, Indian teams have shown competitive spirit and determination.

In the Open category, India secured the 13th position, while missing the cutoff for the top 8 knockout spots. The Mixed team qualified in 12th place and progressed to the Round of 16, where they faced USA team and lost with a score of 216-106 IMPs.

The Senior team has put on an exceptional display, achieving a 3rd-place ranking among the 16 qualifying teams. They advanced by defeating Scotland the Round of 16 and won against Canada in the Quarterfinals, securing semi-final qualification. In the Women's category, India finished 17th, out of 24 countries. The average scores of the Indian Open and Women's teams fell below the qualifying threshold, leaving them virtually out of the run before the final match concluded on the last day.











With the events underway, India remains hopeful for medals, from the Seniors and promising pairs.

The workshop begins at 2 p.m. on 29th April and will conclude at 6 p.m. on 30th April, providing updates on WBF laws and valuable training for directors.
